

NOTICE

Applications are invited to fill posts in the rank of **Police Constable** within the Royal Anguilla Police Force (RAPF).

Police Officers from Anguilla or other legally similar jurisdictions who have **experience** in the role and have already fully **completed** official Police Training are welcome.

The post is in **Grade K** with a starting salary of \$72,024.00 per annum.

Key Duties Include:

- (a) Preserving the public peace.
- (b) Protecting life and property.
- (c) Preventing and detecting crimes.
- (d) Apprehending all persons whom it is lawful to apprehend and for whose apprehension sufficient grounds exist.
- (e) Regulating processions and assemblies in public places or places of public resort.
- (f) Controlling traffic on public thoroughfares and removing obstructions.
- (g) Assisting in preserving order in the territorial waters of Anguilla and enforcing port, maritime, immigration, revenue, fisheries, and import/export laws.
- (h) Executing summonses, subpoenas, warrants, and other processes issued by courts of criminal jurisdiction.
- (i) Laying complaints and prosecuting offenders.
- (j) Assisting in the protection of life and property at fires.
- (k) Attending criminal and civil courts and maintaining order.
- (l) Escorting and guarding persons in lawful custody.
- (m) Performing such functions as the Governor or Commissioner may require for law enforcement or security.
- (n) Performing other functions imposed on a police officer by law.

Qualifications

Applicants must:

- (a) Have fully completed Police Training in a recognized Police Force.
- (b) Hold 3 CXC subjects, including English Language (applicants with less than the minimum qualifications may be considered dependent on training and experience).
- (c) Be of good character and be willing to undertake a vetting process.
- (d) Be physically fit and able to pass a physical fitness test.

In addition, applications are particularly welcome from officers with experience and training in:

- Criminal Investigation
- Criminal Intelligence
- Community-Based Policing
- Marine Policing
- Authorized Firearms Duties
